Family Life Center Payoff: Melanie, our treasurer, informs me that we have \$3,400 to pay off the Family Life Center (FLC) mortgage, which is two more payments. Then, we have about \$5,000 to return to the church treasury to pay for the months that we did not meet our payment costs of \$2,025, which should take us to the month of July to completely pay off our FLC financial obligations. It has been about 8 years, and we have paid off our \$280,000 loan, with the original cost of about \$480,000. This is about 4 years early on our payoff obligation. We can praise the Lord for this! As the coordinator of this facility during the building time, I want to say THANK YOU to my church family for your support. You voted it back then, and we have it today. What a blessing it is to our church and outreach. It will soon be all ours. — Chuck Case.
