HEALTH NUGGET:

Job 12:7-10

7 But ask the animals, and they will teach you, or the birds in the sk;y, and they will tell you; 8 or speak to the earth, and it will teach you, or let the fish in the sea inform you. 9 Which of all these does not know that the hand of the LORD has done this? 10 In His hand is the life of every creature and the breath of all mankind.

Nature walks deliver a powerful longevity boost- - - The great outdoors offers diverse health benefits report researchers in the journal, <u>Environmental Research</u>. In a review of 143 prior studies, increased exposure to "green space" was linked to a 31% decreased risk of mortality, a 28% risk of diabetes, and an 18% decreased risk of stroke. The study authors say walking through a forest (or even viewing trees through a window) relieves stress, limits pollution exposure, and encourages physical activity - - - All of which promote physical and mental health.
