Chef Clinel Walker is originally from Jamaica and has been an Executive Chef for 35 years with three culinary degrees including Cross Cultural Cuisines, and Chinese Cuisines. He is a Vegetarian Food Instructor from the NAD Health Division. He is well-known in New York City and consults for several restaurants and hotels from casual dining to star rated restaurants and hotels.

Clinel Walker was one of the judges for the New York Art Institute's graduating class of 1999 New York Restaurant School and one of the Chefs who created the event for the American 100 Top Chefs.
