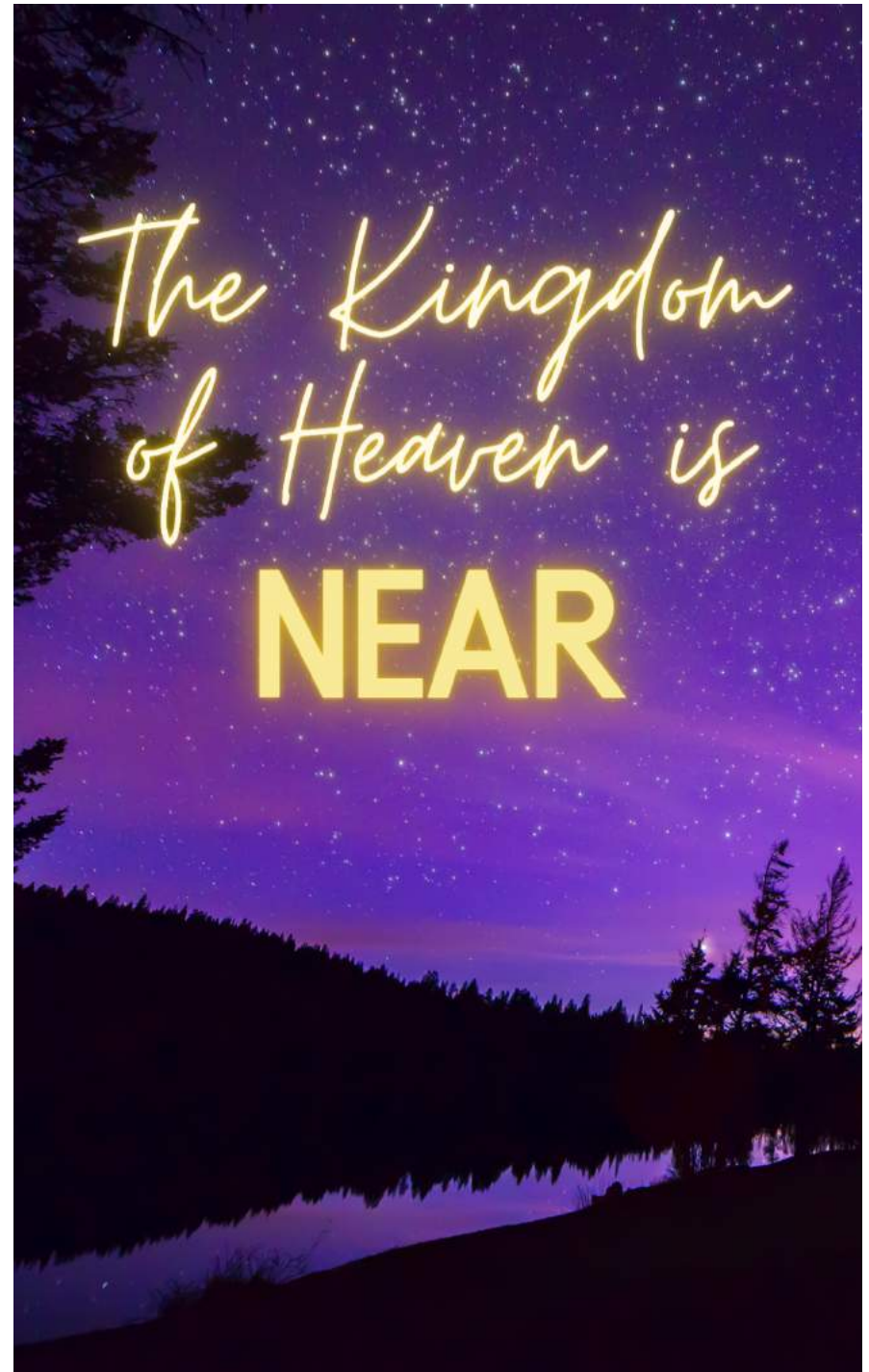

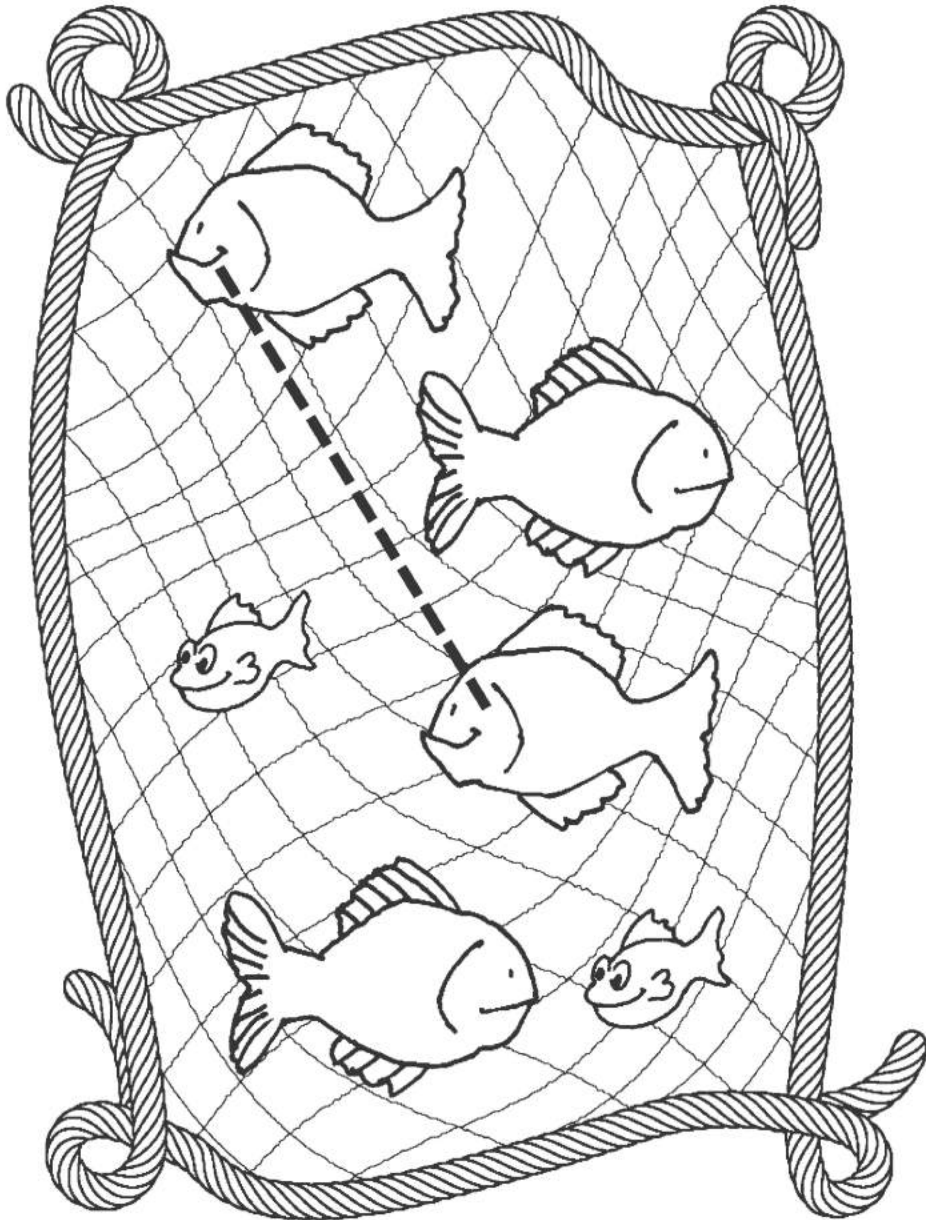
Personal Ministries:

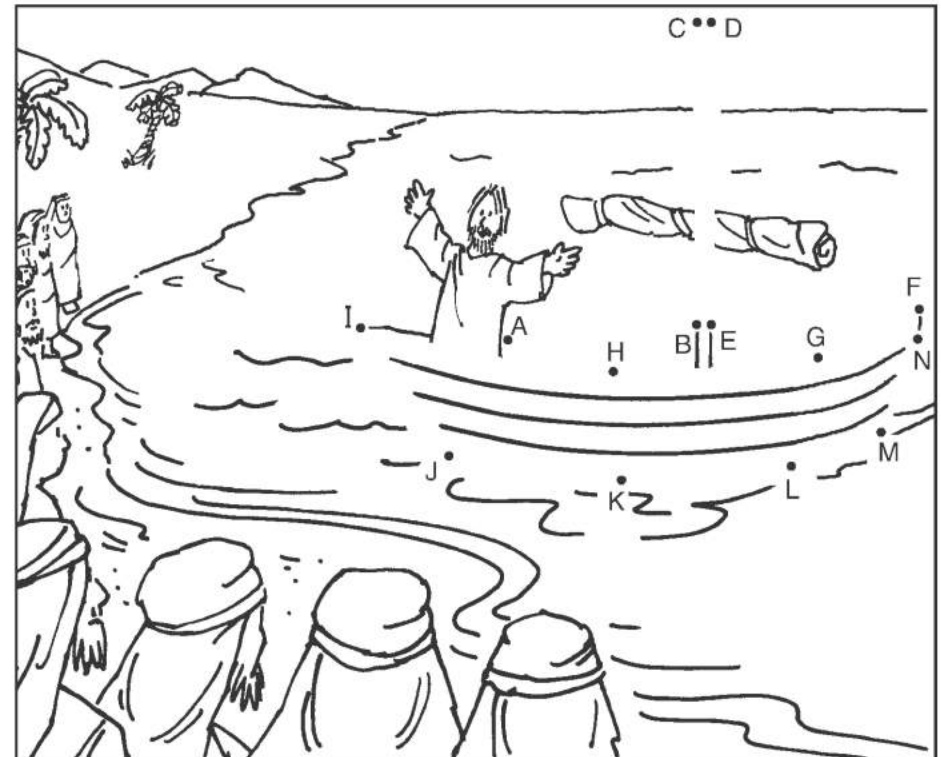

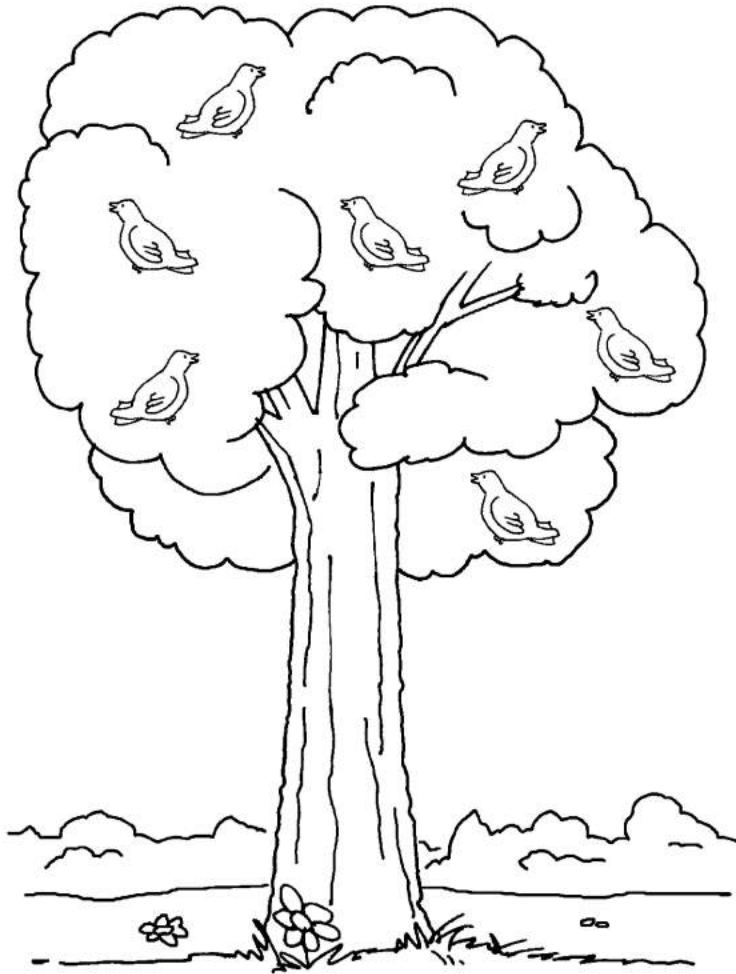
