Potlucks:

Because there will no longer be organized weekly Sabbath visitor potlucks in the FLC, members will need to be more mindful and prepare to invite those who are visiting our church to join them in their own homes for food and fellowship. 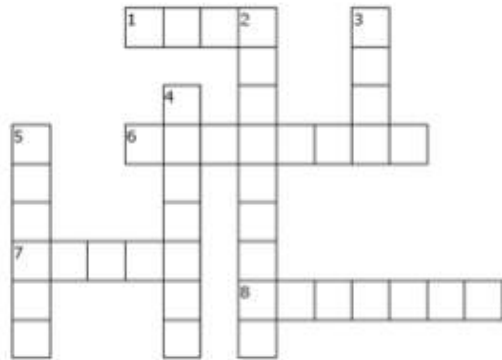

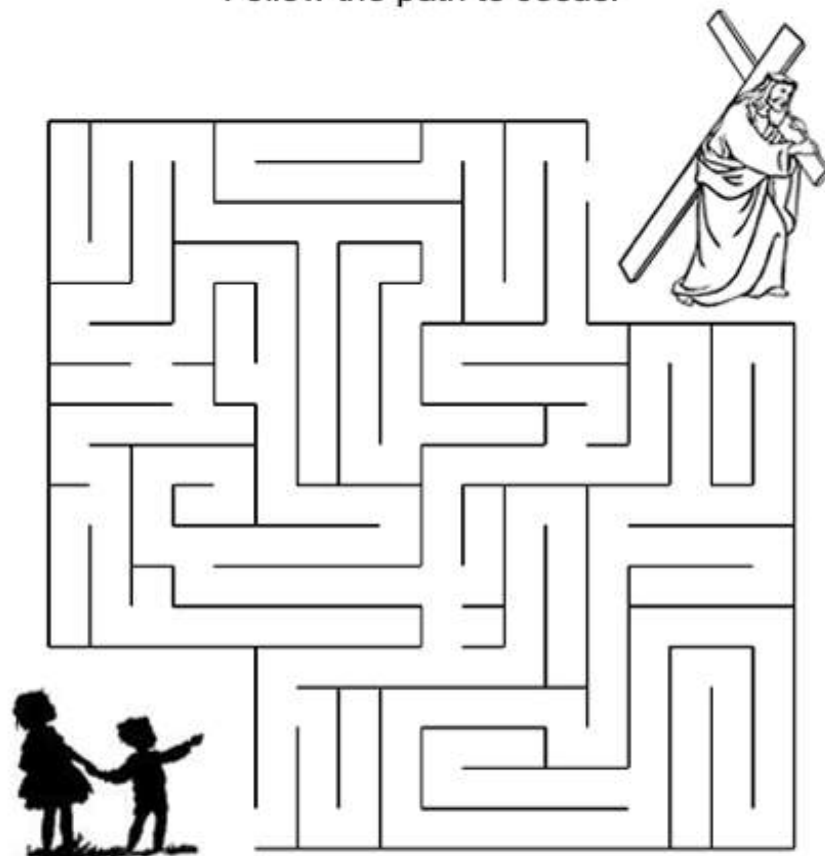
